Thank you for contacting us to see if we can help.

Usually, we can - but we cannot do it alone. Below, is an outline of how we can offer our assistance to help you place a pet or foster that you can no longer provide for.

First things first. Please, refrain from sending us threats of dumping animals at the pound if we refuse to take them off your hands. We cannot take dogs and cats off your hands at this time, so, if you intend to dump them, just do it. Until people start donating to rescue groups on a regular basis so that new buildings can be purchased to house them, food can be bought to feed them, and money taken in to properly vet them, we will continue to have problems.

Now, let's get down to business. This is how we can help.

If you agree to continue to tend to the animal (becoming the foster parent if you will), we will list the animal for adoption on our Petfinder site - where we get hundreds of views a week. This has been a proven success multiple times over. However, it often takes time - weeks or months - to find the proper dedicated home. We will filter each interest ourselves so you don't have to. Once we decide on what could be a proper home, we will put you in contact with the party of interest. It will be up to you, at that point, to set up a meet and greet, and thoroughly feel out the party that wants to adopt said animal in your care.

Every animal must be current on rabies and have a recent wellness check before we will host them on our site. Dogs needs heart worm checks - and preventive treatment if heartworms are already present. Cats must be tested for FIV/Luke and all animals must be parasite free and in good general health.

We will also need multiple HD pics and all information regarding the animal in question - ages, color, breed, behavioral patterns, etc.
